4. STA 2023 must be completed prior to taking ECO 3421.
5. MAC 2311 and ECO 2023 must be completed before taking ECO 4401
6. At Least 12 Hours Of Minor Electives Must Be At 3000 Level or Higher.

MAJORS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A MINIMUM OVERALL GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 3.00 TO REGISTER FOR AN ACADEMIC OVERLOAD (more than 18 hours). PERMISSION MUST BE OBTAINED FROM CHAIRPERSON and DEAN BEFORE REGISTERING. NON-COMPLIANCE WILL RESULT IN STUDENT BEING ADMINISTRATIVELY WITHDRAWN FROM CLASS (ES).
