This curriculum map provides insight and direction for FTIC or Transfer students, with college credits, to graduate in four years. With the assistance of a student's academic advisor, the map will provide a guide between what should be taking term by term and the student's academic progress towards the degree. Courses where substitutions are allowed and milestones are noted on the map and serve as hints regarding what courses and/or activities that must be completed that term. Prerequisites are also noted providing the student and his/her advisor a roadmap of the skills that must be acquired to progress in the curriculum. In this particular document, key prerequisites are listed that can prevent a student from moving along in the curriculum if not satisfied. Also, note that the School of Business and Industry only considers the grade of "C" or better as satisfying the prerequisite. All classes applied towards graduation must be passed with a grade of "C" or better.
